











Step - By - Step Checklist

This process can seem a bit overwhelming at first, so we created this checklist to help you create your very own card deck. It's easier than you think, and we're here to help!

-  **STEP 1.** What kind of card am I making? Affirmation, Tarot, Oracle, Angel, Inspirational, Intuitive, Teaching, Workshop, Marketing, Game, or anything you can think of!
-  **STEP 2.** What size card deck will it be? 3.5" x 5" (most common), 2.75" x 4.75" (tarot), 2.5" x 3.5" (mini), 3.5" x 3.5" (square) or a custom size?
-  **STEP 3.** How many cards will be in my deck? This can be any number, but many decks use 22, 30, 40, 52, 56 or 78 cards. It's really up to you!
-  **STEP 4.** Do I want to include information or instruction cards? These can provide a guide or reference on a how to use the cards and to further explain your deck, if needed.
-  **STEP 5.** Will I use the same image or a different image for every card? Using the same image is much easier to set up, but having a separate image for every card can help your deck look very custom.
-  **STEP 6.** Am I going to design this myself, have a friend design it, or will I hire a graphic designer to create a custom deck for me? If you're designing it yourself, feel free to check out our "How to design a card deck" on our website and/or see our referrals list to some great graphic designers.
-  **STEP 7.** What about packaging... will I use shrinkwrap, a sheer drawstring bag, a custom box or something else?
-  **STEP 8.** Once designed and you're ready to print, go to CardDeckPrinting.com and place your order for you very own card deck... Yay!
